We can start a new class with only 3-4 children. If you and your family or neighbors want to have a class together, call us and let's talk!

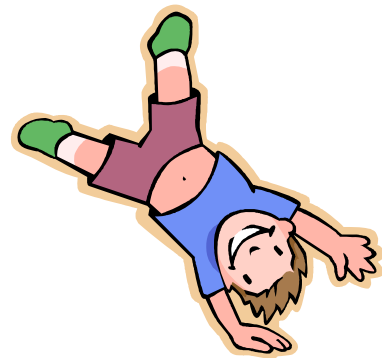

Progressive Tumbling and Cheer Program

Starting in January, we will begin our Progressive Tumbling and Cheer Program. We are sure that this program will help your children become better tumblers and to keep you, the parents, informed of their skill progression.

Here's how the program works:

1. Our coaches will assess each child on their tumbling and cheer (if applicable based on the class) skills.
2. We will record the skills that each child can perform based on the level in which they can perform the skills. The levels are "Significant Assistance", "Minimal Assistance", and "Skills Mastered".
3. Every 4-6 weeks, we will review the skills your child has achieved and the level, and record them on your child's skills sheet.
4. The best part is that we will send the sheet home with your child



every 4-6 weeks so you can see their progress. You can also come in and ask to review the skills sheet for you child at any time.

5. When your child achieves certain skills at the "Skills Mastered" level, they will be able to sign their name to our "Wall of Fame" in the gym.

If you would like to review our skills sheet or if you have questions, please come in and ask at the front desk.
